Imants has performed as a soloist with orchestras in France, Switzerland and Australia.

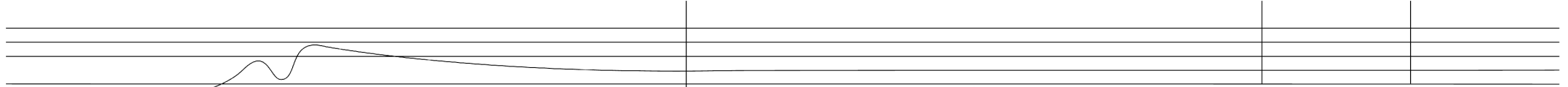
