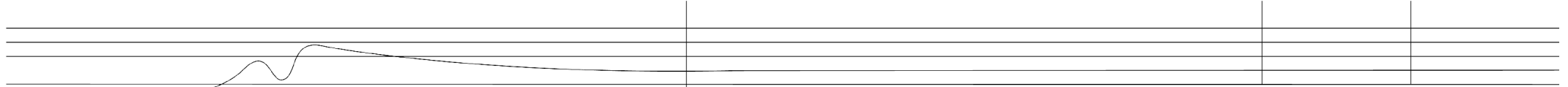
**Gunars & Imants Larsens**

Gunars Larsens was born in Belgium and grew up in Australia, completing his Bachelor of Music with Honours at the Elder Conservatorium. Gunars furthered his studies in Europe, studying with violinists such as Franco Gulli and Josef Suk. In 1974, he joined the Festival Strings Lucerne and went on to lead them as concertmaster and soloist on concert tours to all five continents. He is a Professor of Violin and Chamber Music at the Conservatorium of Music in Lausanne as well as in Lucerne, Switzerland.

Imants Larsens was born in Lucerne and arrived in Australia at the age of 2. After completing his education here, Imants returned to Switzerland to complete his tertiary music studies. He also holds an AMEB Fellowship Diploma in Violin as well as a Licentiate Diploma in Viola. In Europe, Imants has participated actively in master-classes with renowned musicians including Pinchas Zukerman and the Vermeer Quartet. He has performed as a soloist with orchestras in France, Switzerland and Australia.
