Emma plays Tutti Horn with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra and is the Head of Brass at the University of Adelaide's Elder Conservatorium of Music. She is also an Alliance Brass artist. She holds a PhD in Musicology from the University of Adelaide's Elder Conservatorium, and a Bachelor of Music with Class I Honours from the Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University. Emma has performed with the Queensland Symphony Orchestra, West Australian Symphony Orchestra, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, Canberra Symphony Orchestra, Camerata, the Australian Romantic & Classical Orchestra, Adelaide Baroque, Opera Australia's South Pacific, Disney's The Lion King, and at the Tongyeong International Music Festival in South Korea.

Emma is also a composer whose works have been performed across Australia, the USA, Europe, and Japan. Several of her pieces are now also published in the Australian Music Examinations Board (AMEB) Series 2 Horn Syllabus grade books.

Emma is enthusiastic about building and contributing to education and community programs: she maintains a private teaching studio and is the Artistic Director of the Adelaide Horn Jam. She has appeared as a guest tutor at the Queensland Conservatorium Brass Weekend, the Australian Youth Orchestra's National Music Camp, and the Australian Romantic & Classical Orchestra's Young Mannheim Symphonists.
